As you may know, Campus Crusade does not have enough staff members to have dedicated staff on every campus. Some of our staff have several schools under their direction, heavily relying on students to run CCC movements on those campuses. One of these student-run CCC movements is Chadron State College in rural northwest Nebraska. The staff team responsible for this campus lives 8 hours away.

Last spring, the Campus Crusade group at Chadron was all but dead with only 15 involved students. In April a couple of staff members went to the school and within a 24-hour period God raised up a team of 9 excited student leaders.

Then in the fall, after classes had resumed, staff member Brady Cone went to Chadron to get the ministry moving again. He and involved students used a CCC tool called a Freshman Survival Kit (filled with spiritual materials and fun goodies) to gather names of students interested in seeking the Lord. Students had to fill out an interest form to receive a kit. Cone and his students collected 200 student names and met with each and every one of them in the next 2 days. 100 students came to the first Campus Crusade meeting of the semester!

A month later, Cone helped the student leaders to organize an event hosting 9/11 survivor, Sujo John. The day of the event morale was low because the flu had struck campus so badly that the school had to cancel classes! Would anyone show up to the event? Everyone prayed that God would choose to bless the event, and bless it He did! Four hundred students attended and 100 indicated decisions to trust Christ!

In addition, a local pastor and the 9 student leaders were able to talk about Christ with 200 students who attended the event. There are now 15 Bible studies on that campus.

What a difference a year makes! Go God!
